












2025 POP GROUP SELECTION

How can you encourage your child to pursue his/her passion?

1. Encourage him to explore different avenues.

It's important to help encourage your child to get involved with as many different activities as possible. Best still, get the whole family involved!

2. Communication is key: Get to know his passion, leave out any judgement No passion is too big or too small!

3. Nurture the "can do" attitude

Learning something new is not easy.

Grit = passion + perseverance. Grit is the ability to persist in something you feel passionate about and persevere when you face obstacles.

4. Let them dream big.

Some ideas and dreams may sound improbable but they should always be welcomed.

5. Guide them to find balance.

Be sure to maintain a healthy balance by:

- not pushing them too hard: Encourage them to work hard, but allow them some breathing space too.
- guiding your child to find the right balance:
 We do not want them to be overly obsessive that it conflicts with other areas of their life and worse, leads to addiction.
